

Orinda Park Pool Code of Conduct

All members of Orinda Park Pool must sign and acknowledge the Orinda Park Pool Code of Conduct. We ask that all members return a signed copy of this form with the payment of annual dues and assessment, and the emergency contact form. Please keep a copy to share with your family and guests. The Orinda Park Pool Code of Conduct was created to serve as a reminder that the pool is shared by a large group of members, and we all need to work together as a community to keep the pool safe, clean and a fun place to spend our summers. Thank you.

1. Children under the age of 6 must be accompanied to the bathrooms. Please do not allow your child to be alone in the bathrooms. The bathroom is not a play area.
2. The bathroom at the Coaches Shack is limited to use by disabled members, coaches and staff. The bathroom will remain locked and a key must be requested from the lifeguard on duty.
3. Please limit all water usage. If the pool exceeds acceptable water usage, the showers will be turned off. Members should not use the showers to “warm up”, only to shower off quickly.
4. The chairs in the shed are for adults only, not to be used by children for play.
5. All children who are not toilet trained MUST be wearing swimmer diapers.
6. All children under the age of 9 must be accompanied by an adult. All children should be supervised. The lifeguards are not there to supervise children, they are there to save lives.
7. All guests must sign in at the gate and members must accompany guests. Guest fees should be paid at the Canteen. If the Canteen is not open, you must pay your guest fee to the lifeguard on duty. Members are responsible for their guests. Guests must know that they will not be admitted unless the member is present at the gate. You will receive a guest pass that you should keep with you.
8. If you plan to have a party at the pool, you must schedule it with the Pool Manager, confirm the date, and sign a contract for the party. Guest fees must be paid at the time of the party. The member host must greet their guests at the gate, and have them sign in. Guests must know that they will not be admitted unless the member is present at the gate.
9. Members should clean up the pool area when they leave. We need to keep debris out of the pool.
10. Parking is limited to the front lot, and in designated parking areas only. Parking in a no parking area may result in cars being towed. There is designated handicapped parking in both lots.
